

Virtual Sports Week

We are delighted to announce the return of Virtual Sports Week. The Olympics may have been postponed, but we'd love to celebrate this amazing competition by having the Olympics as the theme of the Virtual Sports Week.

The children will be competing for their class teams this time (not their colours). Each class will have a country they are representing. All information on what to do will be in the google classroom from Monday morning 22nd June for children and parents to see.

Mr Jeff has recorded 5 new simple PE activities to complete over the week that can be viewed following the links to his youtube channel. One per day. Children will need to record their best score for each activity in the results table that will be placed into their google classrooms from Monday 22nd June. This results table will remain there all week. The results table must be completed by 3pm Friday 26th, ready for the teachers to count up the scores and for Mr Jeff to collect them all in.

To make this as fair and inclusive as possible we will take in the scores in the following way:

- EYFS/ KS1 to take the top 12 scores (6 boys, 6 girls) from each
- LKS2 class (Y3 and 4) to take the top 10 scores (5 bogs, 5 girls) from each
- UKS2 class (Y 5 and 6) to take the top 8 scores (4 boys, 4 girls) from each

The slight difference this time, is that there will be an opportunity to complete an extra 'non PE' activity linked to your country. Children will be able to see what this activity is on the google slide. The children will receive extra points for their team if they are able to tweet a picture or video to @BandBschool. Mr Jeff will monitor twitter for this.
